

ENTIRE BUILDING AND BASIS FREE SERVICES POLICY

Policy to cover entire library use:

The Gilbert H. Gragg Library, headquarters library of the Southwest Georgia Regional Library System, prohibits discrimination on the basis of race, color, sex, handicaps, age, religion, or national origin. The physical facility and surrounding property, including parking lot, are available to the public during hours of operation, Monday 10 AM- 7 PM, Tuesday through Friday 9 AM - 6 PM, and Saturday 10 AM- 4 PM. Permission to use the library meeting room after hours may be obtained through the circulation desk. There are no restrictions on after hours use of the parking lot.

Basic free services:

Free and open access to all, regardless of race, color, sex, handicaps, age, religion, or national origin, is available for borrowing of books, audiotapes, videotapes, CD's, records and audio-visual equipment. Free in-library use is available for reference materials, newspapers, magazines, genealogy materials, a multipurpose meeting room, homework assistance, and public access computers. Other services which the library offers at a small fee are Interlibrary loan, fax, copy services, and microfilm procurement.
