

## ENTIRE BUILDING AND BASIS FREE SERVICES POLICY

Policy to cover entire library use:

The James W. Merritt Memorial Library prohibits discrimination on the basis of race, color, sex, handicaps, age, religion, or national origin. The physical facility and surrounding property, including parking lot, are available to the public during hours of operation, Monday through Friday from 11:30 AM- 5:30 PM. Permission to use the library meeting room after hours may be obtained through the circulation desk.

Basic free services:

Free and open access to all, regardless of race, color, sex, handicaps, age, religion, or national origin, is available for borrowing of books, audiotapes, videotapes, CD's, records and audio-visual equipment. Free in-library use is available for reference materials, newspapers, magazines, genealogy materials, a multipurpose meeting room, homework assistance, and public access computers. Other services which the library offers at a small fee are Interlibrary loan, fax, copy services, and microfilm procurement.
