Give them to your library!

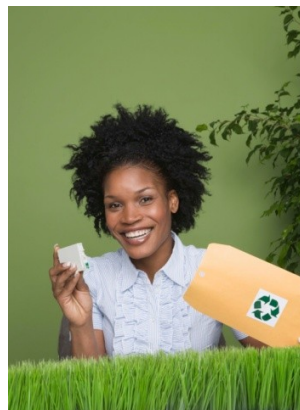

## Introductory Computer Classes

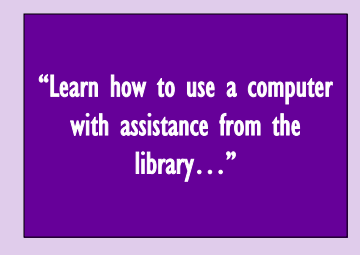
In Decatur and Seminole Counties!
