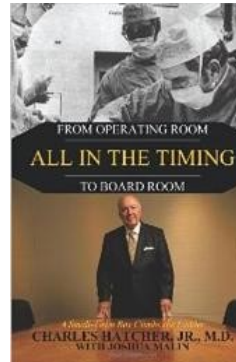
All in the Timing

Tuesday, May 17 from 4-6 p.m.

Join us on **Tuesday, May 17, 2011 from 4—6 p.m.** at the Decatur County – Gilbert H. Gragg Library for a reception honoring Dr. Charles Hatcher, Jr. in celebration of the publication of his new autobiography, All in the Timing: From Operating Room to Board Room.

Born during the Great Depression in Attapulgus, Georgia, Dr. Hatcher earned his M.D. in 1954 from the UGA School of Medicine. He trained at the Johns Hopkins Hospital in Baltimore and Boston's Peter Bent Brigham Hospital

where he learned from the most talented surgeons of the day. In 1962, he returned to Georgia as an assistant professor at Emory University. He performed Georgia's first successful "blue baby" operation using open heart surgery, aortic valve replacement, its first double and triple valve replacements, and its first coronary bypass. In 1971, Dr. Hatcher was named Emory's chief of cardiothoracic surgery and became Director of the Emory Clinic in 1976.

Beginning in 1983, he served as the Director of the Woodruff Health Sciences Center and Vice President for Health Affairs at Emory University in 1996. 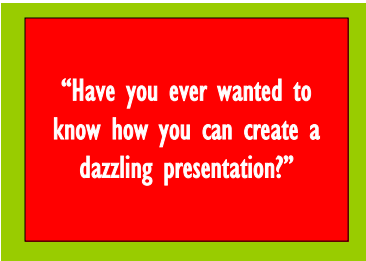

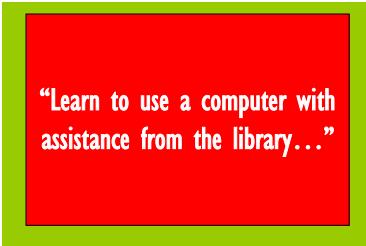
